

## **HEALTH EQUITY** by the numbers

40% of health is determined by social and economic factors



Michigan ranked 29th out of 39 states in overall health care delivered to African American residents

In Michigan, African Americans and American Indians/Alaska Natives are more likely to die prematurely from preventable causes<sup>2</sup>

**African American** deaths per 100,000 people

411.4

AI/AN deaths per 100,000 people

304.1

White deaths per 100,000 people

Nationally, compared to their White counterparts...

African **Americans** are 6% less likely to access health care

**African Americans** age 5-12 & Native American adolescents<sup>5</sup>are 2x more likely to die from suicide
