



There is a mental health crisis in the state of Michigan, and there are not enough psychiatrists to go around.

MC3 helps every Michigan community build capacity to address mental health problems.

Established in 2012, the Michigan Clinical Consultation & Care (MC3) program offers **psychiatry support**, resources, and education to **primary care providers** in over 1,000 clinics in Michigan who treat **pediatric and perinatal patients** with behavioral health problems.

MC3 reduces the need for emergency department visits.
